## SECTION 0.8

### GENERAL INFORMATION

0.8-1 The Contractor shall remove all debris, garbage, equipment and materials from the job site upon completion of the job. During construction, the Contractor shall keep the area in as orderly a condition as possible, being sure to remove all loose debris daily.

0.8-2 The roofing recommendations as outlined herein will be the only system accepted. There will be no deviations accepted except as approved by the Owner, Manufacturer and Roof Maintenance Systems. If there is need for clarification, the bidders will contact:

0.8-3 The approved bidders will be required to visit the job site and review the specifications with the Owner and/or the Owner's Representative when requested. Failure to meet this requirement could result in a bid disqualification.

0.8-4 Prior to the awarding of the contract and prior to starting the job, the successful bidder will be required to meet with the Owner and/or Owner's Representative for a pre-award clarification meeting. Failure to fulfill this requirement could result in the loss of the roofing contract. This meeting is designed primarily for coordination and clarification purposes.

0.8-5 The Roofing Contractor, will, in no way, impede the flow of personnel in the performance of their daily operations, nor will they cause personnel to be inconvenienced by their operations.

0.8-6 Staging area for the re-roofing and repair operations will be agreed upon at the job site meeting.
